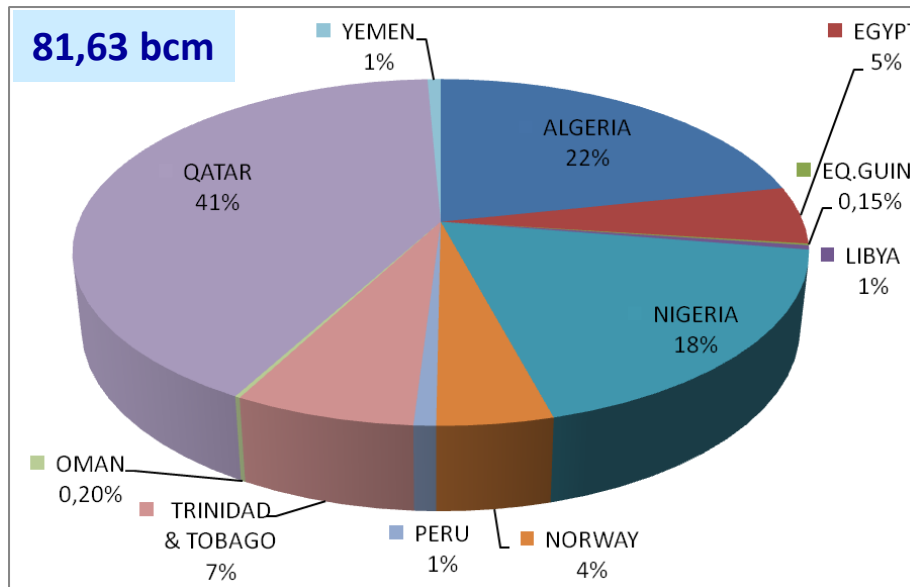

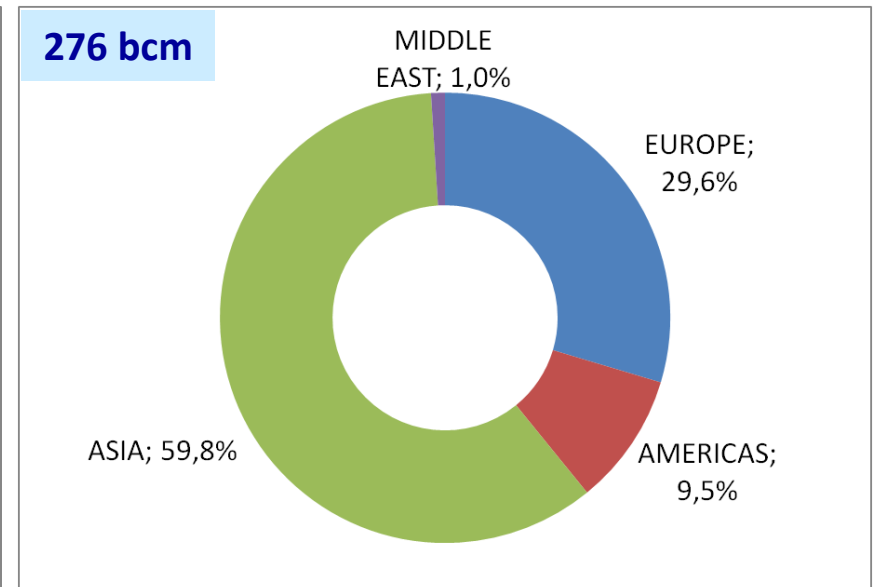

## LNG IMPORTS IN EUROPE PER EXPORTING COUNTRY (2010)

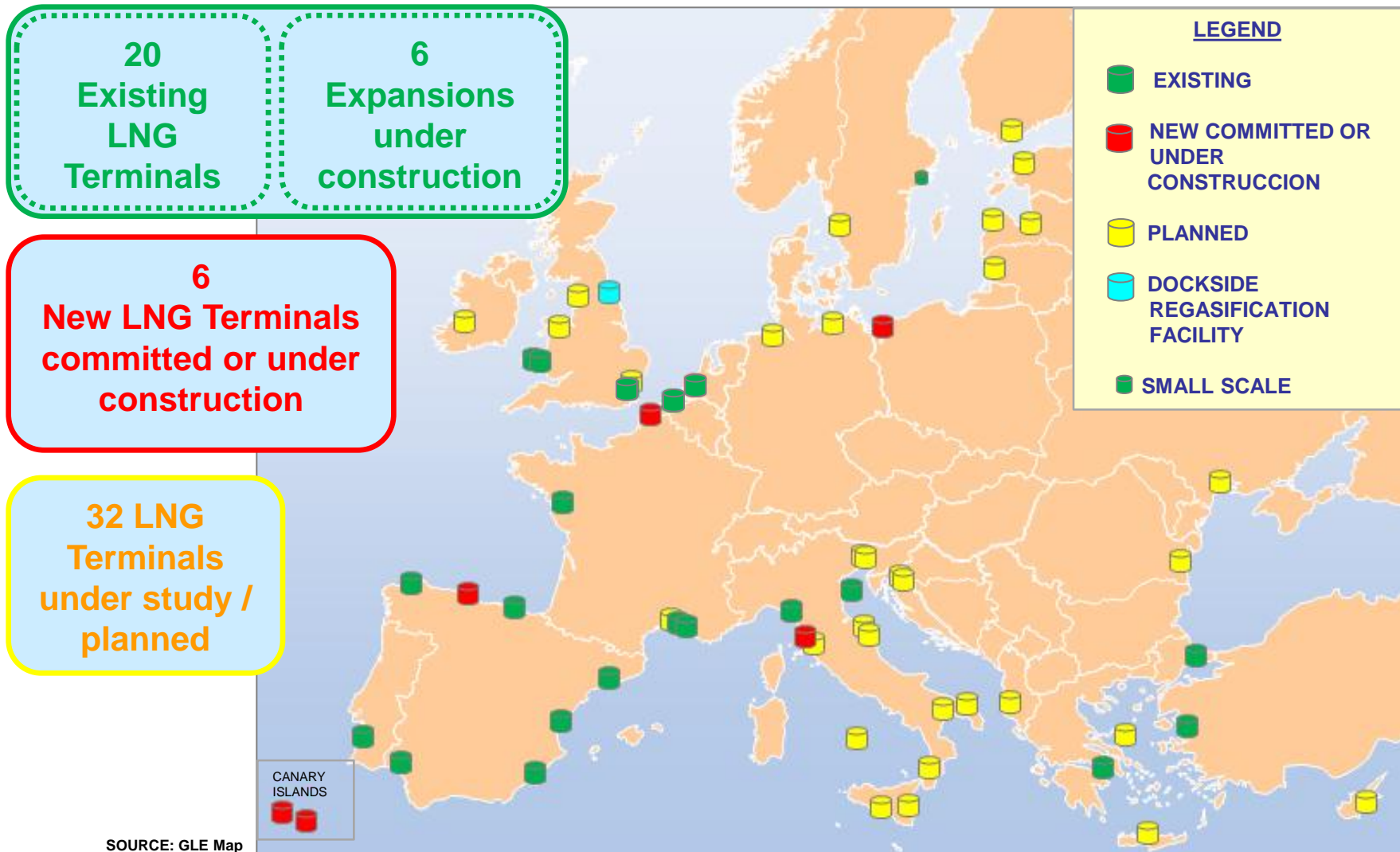


## SHARE OF LNG WORLD IMPORTS (2010)

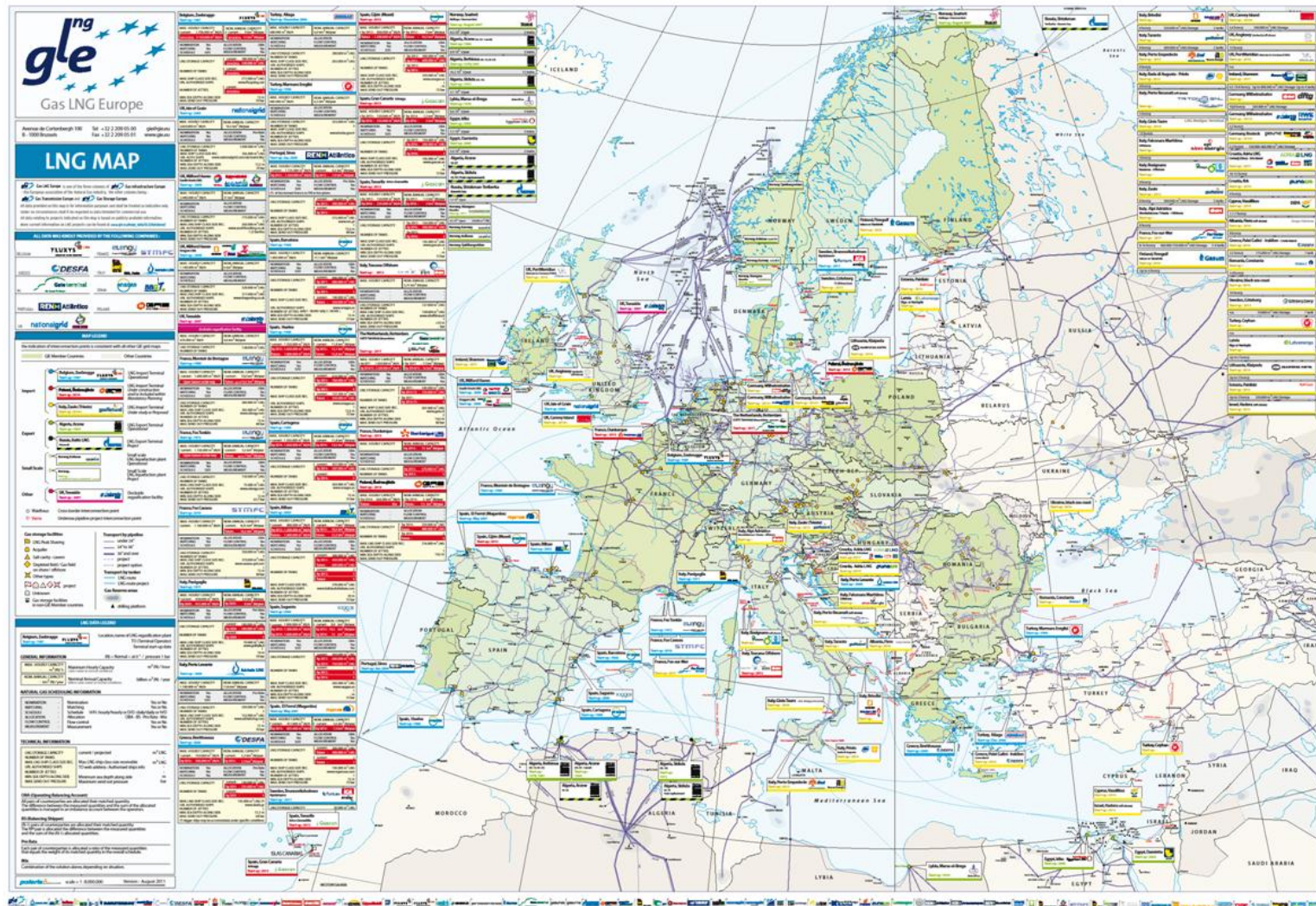

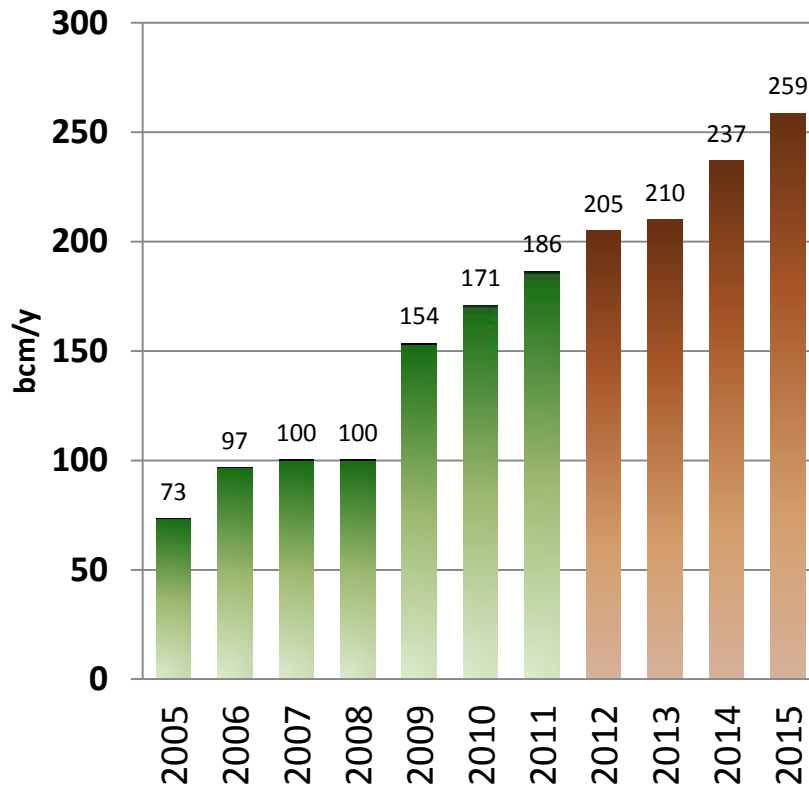

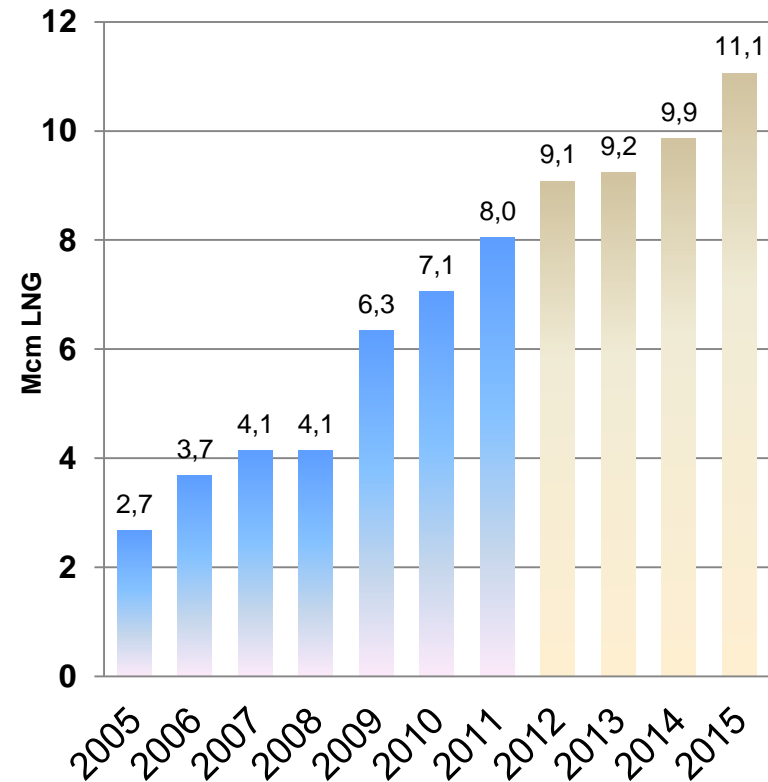
# LNG TERMINALS IN EUROPE EVOLUTION OF CAPACITY



## REGASIFICATION CAPACITY IN EUROPE

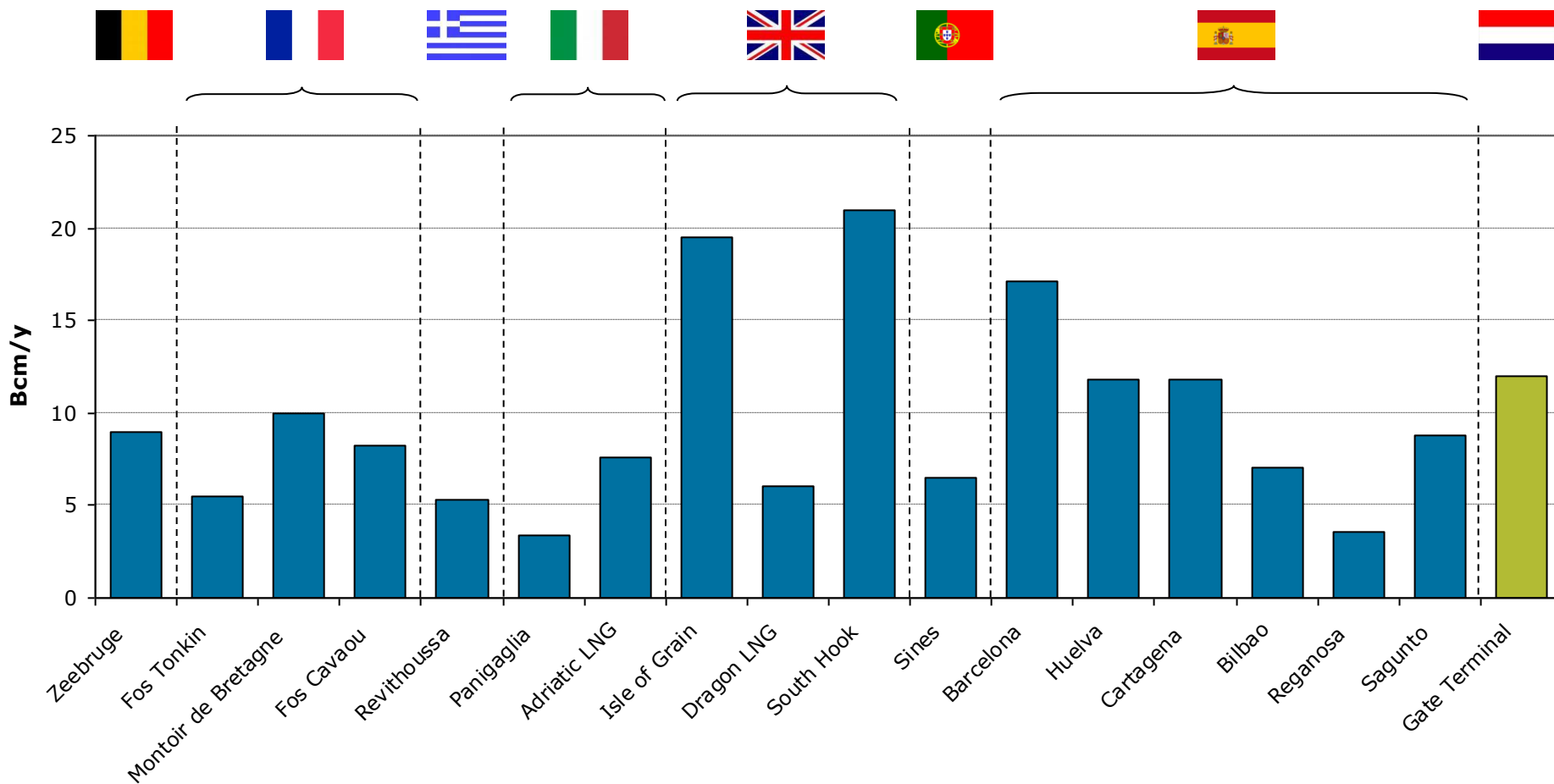


## LNG TERMINALS' STORAGE CAPACITY IN EUROPE

# LNG TERMINALS IN EUROPE: NOMINAL ANNUAL CAPACITY

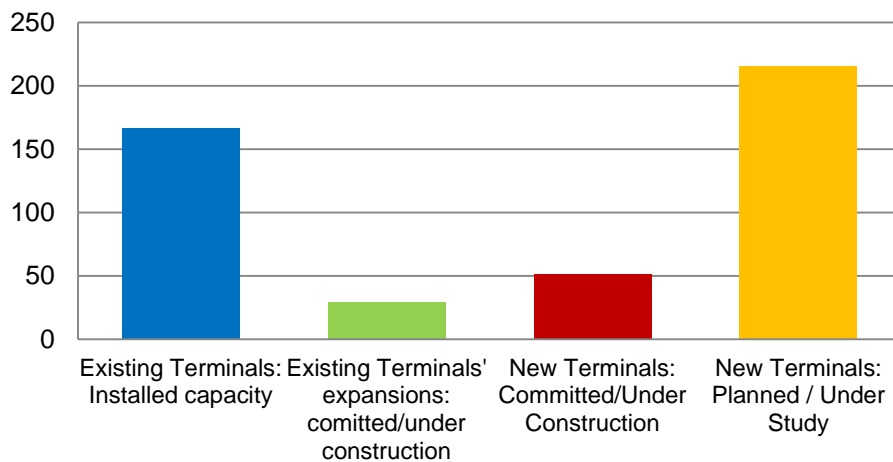

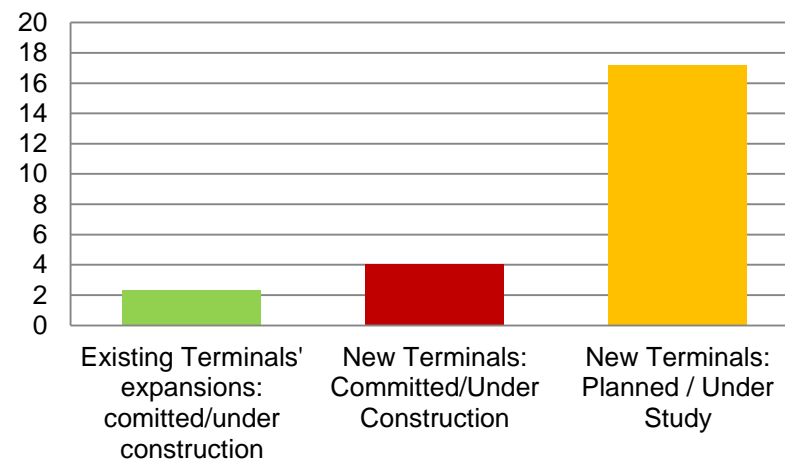
# POTENTIAL LNG INVESTMENTS IN EUROPE 2011-2020

- **Significant Investments ongoing**
- **Allowing Supply Diversification**
- **Increasing Gas Supply competition**
- **Contributing to renewables integration**
- **Long-term commitment (regulatory and/or contractual)**



# ***LAST REMARKS AND CONCLUSIONS***

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- LNG plays different roles in different countries
- LNG contributes to SoS, diversification and competition
- LNG contributes to renewables integration
- LNG provides high level of flexibility
- The price of gas infrastructure is less than 10% of the final price → allows competition on the supplying side and lower prices for consumer
- LNG volumes to EU are increasing (2010/2009: +25 %)

# ***LAST REMARKS AND CONCLUSIONS***

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- Significant investments on LNG going on
- Great uncertainty about planned projects
- Sound Investment Climate is required
  - Regulatory stability
  - Speeding- up permitting and authorisation procedures
  - Same level-playing field between r-TPA and exempted
- Everyone in EU should have access to LNG
